

# New Voter ID Requirements



## Here's what you'll need to vote on May 2

May 2 is an election day, and early voting is currently open at the Hamilton County Board of Elections at 4700 Smith Road in Norwood. **Starting this year, you will need a valid, unexpired photo ID to vote.**

### The only valid forms of ID for voting are:

- a current (unexpired) Ohio drivers license (or interim license)
- a current Ohio state ID (or interim state ID)
- a current US passport
- US military ID
- Ohio National Guard ID
- US Dept of Veterans Affairs ID

### You may not use any of the following as voting ID:

- a utility bill
- a bank statement
- a government or payroll check
- student ID
- county veteran ID
- concealed carry license

**2023 OHIO VOTER ID LAW**

**YES**

- Current Passport or Passport Card
- Current Ohio Drivers License or Interim ID issued by BMV
- Current Ohio State ID or Interim ID issued by BMV

**ALSO YES**

- US military ID
- Ohio National Guard ID
- US Dept of Veterans Affairs ID

**NO**

- Bank Statement
- Utility Bill
- Govt Check
- Payroll Check

**ALSO NO**

- County veteran ID
- Concealed carry license
- Student ID

Please check with friends, family, and neighbors to make sure they are aware of these changes and prepared for election day. **Anyone who doesn't currently have a valid photo ID for voting can get a free Ohio state ID card from any BMV office.**
